



Ivory Coast

The Republic of Ivory Coast (Côte d'Ivoire) is a francophone country with people who are very friendly and hospitable. Nearly 70 percent of Ivorians are under age 30. The country's urban areas are home to a little over half the entire population.

Côte d'Ivoire's technology sector and infrastructure make it the most developed country in West Africa. Animism, Islam, and Roman Catholicism are the dominant religions. Yet the country enjoys religious freedom, so the gospel is not hindered in any way, and individuals are coming to Christ.

NEEDS

Literacy: Illiteracy is alarmingly high, especially among women. Literacy classes can enable people to study and appreciate the Word of God for themselves.

Youth Ministries: The Benjy Youth Center uses sports and children's activities to be a light in its Muslim neighborhood. The goal is to reach and develop the next generation of Christian leaders and laymen.

Theological Training: The Baptist Theological Institute trains men and women for ministry and partners with Ivorian pastors in church planting across Côte d'Ivoire.

Evangelism: There are open opportunities to build relationships and share the gospel with Ivorians through one-on-one or open-air evangelism.
