Summer Internship: Five consecutive weeks May–July

What is it?

This five-week internship program gives you hands-on experience in day-to-day workings of church planting in the Netherlands (Holland).

Cost

Total cost for the trip itself is **\$1,500** (this includes food, lodging, and in-country travel). There is an additional \$40 nonrefundable application fee. Airline ticket, passport fee, and personal spending money are separate.



What Can I Expect?

Receive on-site instruction in the many aspects of church planting, get to know a Dutch family and experience cultural differences up close, and see the Netherlands as a mission field.

Be challenged to stretch your faith and vision, and very possibly find God's will for your life.

Have ample time for sight-seeing (including the Corrie ten Boom House and one of the seven wonders of the world), day trips, and much more.

Qualifications

You must be seriously interested in world missions and willing to jump right in. Come with an open heart to what God wants to teach you. Most Dutch people speak English, and you will be able to learn the adaptation process for a new and exciting culture. Lastly, we ask that you be willing to submit to the BMM doctrinal statement and have pastoral approval.

Applications must be in our office by February 15, 2022.
